10am Meeting group at Bloom entrance (see map attached) with entry tickets

10.20 –11.30 Music and biodiversity workshop.

Making musical instruments out of recycled materials with a group of young people. The musicians will work with young people to make a song for biodiversity.

Making species flags to celebrate international year of biodiversity based on species representing different countries involved in the summer school.

11.30 - 12.20 Music and talk - Performances from EU delegates with young people showing flags

12.20 – 13.00 Discussion with scientists and audience participants about biodiversity in a European context with a focus on the future of the species represented and action needed.

13.00 – 14.00 Lunch

14.00 – 16.00 Phoenix Park field trip with Billy Flynn – IWT ecologist, discovering urban biodiversity in Europe's largest park and discussing park management techniques.

16.00 Conclusions, Recommendations and Pictures Pooled.

Results collected before we leave train as 1. Bones of a train viewer 2. Action points to improve, resolve to explain or write about.
